2018 QLD SURF LIFE SAVING CHAMPTONSHIPS

BMD Northcliffe Surf Club took out their 15th consecutive QLD Championship Pointscore on the Sunshine Coast on the weekend.

We had success across all age groups in individual and team events throughout the weekend but a standout was certainly Mitchell Coombes who won 6 gold including a convincing victory in the U19 Ironman as well as 5 bronze medals.

We had great results in the major finals on Sunday with Courtney Hancock taking out the Open Ironwoman, Shannon Eckstein claiming victory in the Surf Race, Cory Hill in the Open Male Ski Race and Harriet Brown in the Open Female Board Race. Success continued through to the final event of the day with BMD Northcliffe taking out the coveted Open Male Taplin Relay Championship.

SATURDAY 17 MARCH - MAROOCHYDORE

Jake Moore was involved in a rescue at the QLD Surf Life Saving Champs at Maroochydore on Saturday afternoon.

Jack was lining up for the U19 Taplin when four Asian tourists swimming outside of the flags were swept out to sea at Maroochydore. Jack along with other competitors from Kurrawa, Burleigh and Alexandra Headland paddled out to the tourists who had their hands in the air waving and were gasping for air.

The fully dressed tourists were pulled on to the competitor's boards and brought safely back to shore.

MONDAY 19 FEBRUARY - NORTHCLIFFE

Our Manager on Duty in the Supporters Club spotted 3 swimmers in trouble in front of the club at 5:15pm. Beaches had been closed that day with dangerous surf conditions caused by Cyclone Gita.

Hannah Sculley and Maddy Dunn who were working upstairs at the time & Lee Vrolyks who was working in the office ran down to the beach with a board and 2 tubes and entered the water fully dressed in their work uniforms to rescue the 3 teenage boys. 2 of the boys made it safely back on to their feet but one had been swept out passed the shore break and was in a lot of trouble. Maddy & Lee got to the boy allowing him to hold on to a tube and rest as had swallowed a bit of water. He was then brought safely back to shore. It's handy having Life Savers that work at the club!

PATROL INCENTIVES

The Membership Bursary was established to recognise and reward the significant contribution that many of our patrolling members make to our club each season in a variety of roles. These include Patrol Captain, 70+ patrol hours, obtaining multiple awards, officiating at multiple carnivals, training & assessing at multiple courses and being a Lifesaving Committee member. THE JAPANESE CONNECTION

It has been an absolute pleasure working with 3 members of our Japanese sister club, Otake SLSC, for them to be awarded the Bronze Medallion. "Mini", "Muscles" and "Sleepy" flew through the assessment with flying colors after spending the week here training with us earlier this month. The collaboration with Otake has been ongoing for over



20 years and is invaluable to both clubs.

NEW EQUIPMENT

We have recently taken delivery of a new IRB motor, 3 Bennett soft rescue boards, 10 rescue tubes and a pair of binoculars courtesy of the Australian Government's Beach Safety Equipment Fund. This initiative aims to ensure that Australia's surf lifesavers have the vital safety equipment needed to keep our beaches safe and is much appreciated.

INTERNATIONAL LIFESAVING

In addition to supporting our members on ISLA (International Surf Lifesaving Association) missions, BMD Northcliffe have established a bursary to assist one of our training team each year to take part in these wonderful projects. The club has also donated surf rescue boards, rescue tubes and patrol uniforms to help with ISLA's vision to assist developing countries with advanced training and equipment, so that they can better serve their ocean communities.
