Our Life Saving Committee have managed their responsibilities admirably again this season and on behalf of all members I wish to thank them all, and in particular, Jonathon King, our Club Captain and Tim Burgess, Vice President Life Saving, for the tireless work and countless hours on the beach ensuring that our commitment to saving lives is professionally administered.

The success of our lifesaving and education services here at the club are predominantly due to the professional management delivered by our Manager of Lifesaving & Education, Caroline Fildes and our Lifesaving Admin Assistant, Christie Short. As saving lives is our primary purpose, we should all be very proud of the level of service we do provide.

Our Junior Activities Program were busy throughout the summer, introducing over 380 members to becoming future surf lifesavers for our Club. A program that can involve the whole family through a wide and varied range of activities, organized and supervised by experienced and compassionate senior surf life savers.

Their season culminated with an excellent result at the Queensland Youth Championships.

A great result for all those involved, and a huge thank you must go out to Jake Nicholson, Junior Head Coach, and Imogen Rees, Junior Assistant Coach for working so well together as a team and providing such professional and caring tuition and coaching to our young members.

A very special thanks to Elena Davis, Junior Activities Coordinator, Shannon Van Balen, Stephen Fry, Vice President Youth Development, Graham Adams and the Junior Activities Committee, all the Age Managers, their assistants, water safety, IRB drivers and crew and all our members that have assisted in any way for such an integral part of this club.

Our Surf Sports program provides our members with opportunities to showcase their skills and talent to other members within our organization and also to the general community, and it certainly provided plenty of excitement throughout the season, with the Club hosting its 3rd Shaw and Partners Shannon Eckstein Ironman Classic in what was amazing surf. An "All of Club" effort to conduct this event, which is surely becoming regarded as the "Premier" event on the calendar, especially considering \$130k Cash Prizes are up for grabs!

The Aussies were held up the Sunshine Coast in April, with the Open Championships producing the most Gold Medals ever won by a single Club in the history of Surf Sports.

Thirty three (33) Gold Medals together with three Gold from the Youth Championships proves our programme works!

Winning the Overall Champion Club Trophy by 203 points, which ironically is more than the 33 Gold Medals we won, winning the Under 17 Champion Club Trophy, the Under 19 Champion Club Trophy, the Open Champion Club Trophy and the Handicap Champion Club Trophy. What an Incredible performance from all our members.

Our Open & Under 19 Head Coach's in Naomi Flood (Women) and Kev Morrison (Men), together with Gavin Hill, Head Coach of Under 14, 15 & 17, worked tirelessly

together with tremendous results across all age groups throughout a very long competition season.

Sincere appreciation and congratulations to our Manager of Surf Sports Mark Williams, Vice President Surf Sports Brian Booth, the Surf Sports Committee, our Team Managers, Officials, IRB drivers/crew, water safety and all our other members and professional staff who have assisted the club during the season in the provision of our Surf Sports Program.

# REPORTS

## MANAGER OF LIFE SAVING AND EDUCATION REPORT

Northcliffe Surf Clubs core business is prevention, the saving of lives, educating the public and being a proud member of a great Australian tradition of volunteer surf lifesaving. Fortunately for our club we have over 300 patrolling members that actively follow that philosophy and they are an impressive group:

- 36 members were awarded a SLSA National Patrol Service award in recognition of their long service to lifesaving patrols. All of these members have completed over 10 years' service and 3 members have completed 20, 30 and 35-years' service.
- 8 of these members have been fulfilling one of the clubs most important roles, that of Patrol Captain, for more than 10 consecutive years, 2 of them for 20 years.
- Collectively they have contributed 13205 hours of their precious time this season.

I would like to acknowledge our long service members that continue to patrol and assist our teams with their vast experience and also the group of members that answered an SOS from Rainbow Bay SLSC to take over several of their patrol slots this season. This group, led by our Club Captain Jonathan King, made the trek down to Rainbow Bay four times. Not only did they assist a fellow club but came back with an understanding of a vastly different beach and a different way to patrol. Our Patrol Captains take time out of their busy lives to manage their patrols on top of work, home and other commitments. Without their beach and people management skills we would not be able to provide the excellent service that we do to the beach going public.

Our IRB team continues to be actively involved in supporting our clubs many activities that go beyond patrols and include Nipper Sundays, Club championships, proficiencies and carnivals. Special mention to the excellent team work provided at the Shannon Eckstein Ironman Classic in very difficult conditions.

We have once again been very fortunate to receive funding from grants to purchase essential equipment. We have welcomed 2 new IRB's, a motor (with two more arriving soon) and a water rescue manikin to aid with IRB training.

Our training team have welcomed two new trainers and have three more in training to be qualified in the next season. Three of our trainers are completing their Assessors award and one more completing the Facilitators award, working toward higher professional accreditation. We have

a real focus on continuing to develop and educate our training team so that our members are receiving the best possible training in all areas.

Bronze Medallion training underwent some changes for 2020/21 both with content and delivery platforms. Our training team went on to deliver 3 Bronze, 3 SRC, 2 IRB courses and over 1100 individual proficiencies.

Skills Maintenance (proficiencies) is always a huge challenge for the team but the tweaks we apply every year are designed to make the process as simple as possible whilst delivering essential new information/skills and ensuring our members are always "rescue ready". An enormous thank you to each and every one of our training team for their generosity in investing their time into our club members education.

There is no "off season" at our club with the "on season" preparation beginning the day after our flags go down for the season. Thank you to the Lifesaving Committee and all our professional staff for your support throughout the year. From weekly operational tasks to strategic directions, your assistance is greatly valued.

In finishing I would like to relate an incident that occurred on our beach on 25th October 2020. It was a busy Sunday morning with patrol and Nippers on the beach when two of our Nipper dads noticed a member of the public return from a swim and then collapse on his towel just metres from the patrol van. They alerted the patrol and 4 of our very experienced members, Graham Adams, Sheldon Alcantara, Scott Bradford and Dave Bryant swung into action. After ascertaining that he was not breathing they commenced CPR and a shock was administered by AED (automated external defibrillator). This was followed by a number of chest compressions and then the man began to show signs of life. Paramedics arrived and he was transported to hospital and underwent heart bypass surgery the next day. He has since made a full recovery and is forever grateful to our members and club for saving his life.

We are extremely proud of these members and in fact every one of our patrolling members for actively following our philosophy of saving lives on Northcliffe beach.

I hope you all have a safe and relaxing Winter and look forward to seeing you all for season 2021/22.

In particular I would like to acknowledge the tireless efforts of Caroline Fildes and Christie Short who continually go out of their way to ensure that lifesaving runs smoothly.


Our Lifesaving Division is in an extremely strong position moving forward to the next season. We have good volunteer numbers and our lifesaving equipment is in near new condition.







Teams took home 33 golds, 15 silver and 13 bronze medals.

This shows the continued improvement in enthusiasm, skills, depth and speed our athletes are building on each year and is a wonderful testament to the continued commitment BMD Northcliffe has given to Pool Rescue over the years. It was disappointing

an Australian Championships wasn't able to go ahead but that has made us even more hungry for 2021. Our goal is clear – Australian Champions. We will settle for nothing less.

Thank you to everyone who helped out with coaching, time keeping, team managing, putting up tents and so much more. # REPORTS

## VICE PRESIDENT FINANCE'S REPORT

**Despite the COVID-19 situation impacting a large part of the Surf Club year in 2020/21, BMD Northcliffe has continued to maintain a positive financial position.**

At the start of the pandemic and with both clubs shutdown, the Surf Club instituted a Joint Emergency Operational Committee (JEOC) with the Supporters Club to assess the commercial impacts of the pandemic on all aspects of both clubs. Fortunately, through federal job keeper funding and the successful commercial rebounding of the Supporters Club along with actions of the JEOC to reduce operational and discretionary costs, the club maintained financial stability. Importantly all permanent staff retained employment with the club through this period.

Looking at financial performance, the club delivered a surplus of \$768,496 (previous year deficit \$127,747). The main contributors to this result were the increase in Supporters Club donations (\$335,384) and job keeper funding (\$365,000). Overall expenses were also down by \$148,667 against the prior year.

The club balance sheet remains solid with a net asset position of \$4.188 million (last year \$3.419 million). Most notably the outstanding loan position has reduced by \$813,021. Cash levels continue to remain sound.

A special mention to our professional and hard-working finance and administration teams ably led by Karen Markus and Lee Vrolyks. Their commitment is fantastic and they make the operations of this busy club run efficiently and effectively.

The 2020/21 year was one like no other and the financial stewardship of the club took on even greater importance. I would like to pass on my personal vote of thanks to the management committees of the Surf Club and Supporters Club who diligently review and discuss the financial aspects of the respective entities and ensure we continue to be a successful and sustainable club.

I look forward to a next year where the club will continue to advance from our stable financial position.

# NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2021

## Note 1 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The financial statements are special purpose financial statements prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Queensland 1981. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The committee have determined that the accounting policies adopted are appropriate to meet the needs of the ACNC. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with AASB 101 Presentation of Financial Statements; AASB 107 Statement of Cash Flows; AASB 108 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and errors; AASB 1048 Interpretation of Standards and AASB 1054 Australian Additional Disclosures.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated specifically, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise, have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements.

### (a) Income Tax

The Northcliffe Surf Life Saving Club is a charitable institution for the purposes of Australian taxation legislation and is therefore exempt from income tax.

### (b) Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

Property, plant and equipment is carried at cost accumulated depreciation, except for buildings under Buildings & Leasehold Improvements which are carried at fair value.

The carrying amount / fair value of plant and equipment is reviewed annually by the committee members to ensure it is not in excess of the recoverable amount from those assets. The recoverable amount is assessed on the basis of the expected net cash flows which will be received from the assets employment and subsequent disposal. The expected net cash flows have not been discounted to present values in determining recoverable amounts.

Increases in the carrying amount arising on revaluation of land and buildings are credited to a revaluation of reserves in equity. Decreases that offset previous increases of the same asset are charged against fair value reserves directly in equity; all other decreases are charged to the income statements. Each year the difference between depreciation based on the revalued carrying amount of the asset charged to the income statement and depreciation based on the assets' original cost is transferred from the revaluation reserve to retained earnings. The Club received a valuation from the insurer in the current period

and performs external valuations every three years.

The depreciation rates used for each class of depreciable assets are:

Motor Vehicles	15%-25%
Furniture & Fixtures	5% - 33%
Gear & Equipment	10% - 33%
Office/Computer Equipment	25% - 40%
Buildings & Leasehold Improvements	5% - 20%

During the year there has been a new Motor vehicle acquired through a lease option.

### (c) Impairment of Assets

At the end of each reporting period, the committee reviews the carrying amounts of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, an impairment test is carried out on the asset by comparing the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value in use, to the asset's carrying amount. Any excess of the asset's carrying amount over its recoverable amount is recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

### (d) Leases

Leases of PPE, where substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to the ownership of the asset (but not the legal ownership) are transferred to the association, are classified as finance leases.

Finance leases are capitalised by recording an asset and a liability at the lower of the amounts equal to the fair value of the leased property or the present value of the minimum lease payments, including any guaranteed residual values. Lease payments are allocated between the reduction of the lease liability and the lease interest expense for that period.

Leased assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the shorter of their estimated useful lives or the lease term. Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

### (e) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

### (f) Cash Assets

Cash assets includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, and other short-term highly liquid

investments with original maturities of three months or less. Bank overdrafts are shown within short-term borrowing in current liabilities on the Statement of Financial Position.

### (g) Accounts Receivable and Other Debtors

Accounts receivable and other debtors include amounts due from members as well as amounts receivable from donors. Receivables expected to be collected within 12 months of the end of the reporting period are classified as current assets. All other receivables are classified as non-current assets.

### (h) Revenue and Other Income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Grant and donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

If conditions are attached to the grant that must be satisfied before the association is eligible to receive the contribution, recognition of the grant as revenue will be deferred until those conditions are satisfied.

Fundraising and Sponsorship income is recorded when the agreement between the Surf Club and the sponsor has been settled and invoice is raised. This income is derived by the Club's Fundraising Manager and recorded on invoice raised.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax.

### (i) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of associated GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). In this case it is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of the expenses. Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the assets and liabilities statement.

### (j) Financial Instruments

Recognition and Initial Measurement Financial instruments, incorporating financial assets and financial liabilities, are recognised when the entity becomes

a party to the contractual provisions of the instruments. Trade date accounting is adopted for financial assets that are delivered within timeframes established by marketplace convention.

Financial instruments are initially measured at fair value plus transactions costs where the instrument is not classified as at fair value through profit or loss. Transaction costs related to instruments classified as at fair value through profit or loss are expensed to profit or loss immediately. Financial instruments are classified and measured as set out below.

### Classification and Subsequent Measurement

#### i) Loans and receivables

Loans and receivables are non-derivative financial assets with fixed or determinable payments that are not quoted in an active market and are stated at amortised cost using the effective interest rate method.

#### ii) Financial liabilities

Non-derivative financial liabilities are recognised at amortised cost, comprising original debt less principal payments and amortisation.

#### (k) Trade and Other Payables

Trade and other payables represent the liability outstanding at the end of the reporting period for goods and services received by the association during the reporting period that remain unpaid. The balance is recognised as a current liability with the amounts normally paid within 30 days of recognition of the liability.

#### (l) Economic Dependence

Northcliffe Surf Life Saving Club Inc is dependent on the Northcliffe SLS Supporters Association Inc for funds used to meet its financial commitments. At the date of this report the management committee has no reason to believe the Northcliffe SLS Supporters Association Inc will not continue to support Northcliffe Surf Life Saving Club Inc.

#### (m) Bank Loan – Security

The security for the bank loan is:

## Opinion

The financial report has been prepared to assist Northcliffe Surf Life Saving Club Inc. to meet the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981 and Division 60 of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

## Other Information

Those charged with governance are responsible for the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the Association's annual report for the year ended 30 April 2020, but does not include the financial report and our auditor's report thereon.

Our opinion on the financial report does not cover the other information and accordingly we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon.

In connection with our audit of the financial report, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial report or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated.

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If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information, we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard.

## Responsibilities of Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Report

Those charged with governance of the Association are responsible for the preparation of the financial report that gives a true and fair view and have determined that the basis of preparation described in

Note 1 to the financial report is appropriate to meet the needs of the members and meet the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981 and Division 60 of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012.


